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Overview:

- ExxonMobil Canada Properties, by its managing partner ExxonMobil Canada Ltd. (EMCP) and Hibernia Management and Development Company Ltd. (HMDC) are in the process of pre-qualifying companies who can supply <u>4D seismic (acquisition) surveying (2024)</u> for their offshore Newfoundland and Labrador requirements.
- Supplier shall provide all management, personnel, processes, materials, tools, equipment, applicable certifications and facilities as may be required to ensure all equipment covered by this pending Agreement shall be fabricated and supplied to meet all statutory requirements, codes of practice and applicable specifications.
- The intention is to have this scope of work cover the requirements of the Hibernia Project*, and the Hebron
 Project. For clarity, the scope of work includes not only the foregoing, but may include at EMCP and/or
 HMDC's discretion, future work related to minor changes to the scope of work described herein, in which
 EMCP and/or HMDC may engage onshore or offshore Newfoundland and Labrador, for oil and gas facilities
 as well as exploration or subsea related activities
- While not planned, it should be noted that the resulting Request For Proposal (RFP) and Agreement may require inclusion of and/or extension to other operators in the area, project co-venturers, suppliers and/or affiliated companies.
- For work related to the Hibernia Project*, HMDC supports providing opportunities to Canadian, and, in particular, Newfoundland and Labrador companies and individuals, on a commercially competitive basis. Suppliers expressing interest in providing services or materials, if they are selected to bid, will be required to complete a Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Benefits Questionnaire at the bid stage.

Scope of Work Overview:

The scope of work/supply includes, but is not limited to:

- Acquisition of high-quality time-lapse (4D) monitor seismic multi-component streamer data covering Hibernia & Hebron fields in 2Q-3Q 2024.
- The program is expected to consist of up to 700 square kilometers (Hebron: ~300 km²; Hibernia: ~400 km²) of acquisition of 4D marine seismic and navigation data, an undershoot program (consisting of two seismic vessels) and a box-in program (Hebron: ~35 km²; Hibernia: ~45 km², subject to change).

Additionally, the selected supplier will be required to meet all technical and Safety, Security, Health, and Environmental (SSHE) specifications and safe work practices of EMCP, HMDC, and their affiliates as appropriate.

Minimum Technical Requirements

1. Contractor will be required to acquire multi-component (e.g. hydrophone and geophone) 4D seismic data in the Grand Banks area with at least one seismic streamer vessel, one seismic source vessel (for undershoot program only) and two support vessels (e.g. support and escort).

2. The seismic vessel(s) supplied must have, at a minimum the following requirements:

- Hull and machinery less than 20 years old
- Seismic recording navigation, energy source and multi-component streamers (for the streamer vessel) that are well maintained and functional
- For the streamer vessel: capable of towing 12 solid, multi-component streamers with a minimum length of 4500 meters per multi-component streamer and have at least 360 traces at 12.5 m spacing

3. Source will be dual (flip-flop) compressed air source array, with arrays in the range of 3000 to 5000 cubic inches, output at least 80 bar-meters and primary to bubble ratio of at least 15:1.

4. Contractor shall supply an onboard real-time fully integrated navigation and QC system suitable for quality control of all aspects of the navigation and positioning activities.

5. Contractor shall supply an onboard processing system capable of producing a 'quick-look' cube. In addition to this cube, the processing system will also be required to produce an edited SEG-Y dataset with final geometry in the trace headers.

6. Vessel must be available for acquiring the survey from on or about May 15 through on or about September 30, 2024.

Submission Requirements

Supplier submissions in response to this Expression of Interest (including pre-qualification) **must** include the afore-mentioned reference number, as well as the following information:

1. Completed EMCP / HMDC SSHE pre-qualification questionnaire. (Available through BIDS – see contact information below.)

3. Information demonstrating qualification for the Scope of Work detailed above.

4. Information demonstrating vendor can meet minimum technical requirements detailed above.

Describe your experience operating under and familiarity with the benefits provisions of the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Act, and your experience with any similar regimes in other parts of Canada or internationally. At the Non-Binding Request For Proposal (NRFP)/Invitation To Tender (ITT) stage, bidders will be required to indicate how they comply with the above.

6. Please acknowledge that responsible management personnel have read, understand, and will support requirements to comply with the following where applicable

- i. Section 45 of the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Act

This Expression of Interest (including pre-qualification) is not a pre-qualification of suppliers for other EMCP / HMDC work, but is limited to the scope aforementioned. In addition, participation in this Expression of Interest (including pre-qualification), including any statements whether oral or written between EMCP / HMDC and your company, shall not create or be deemed to create any binding legal relationship or contract, or be construed to do so between EMCP / HMDC and your company. All costs associated with the preparation of your response to this expression of interest shall be at your expense.

This Expression of Interest (including pre-qualification) may or may not result in the issuance of a NRFP/ITT and may or may not result in the award of an agreement. If you respond to this Expression of Interest (including prequalification) and your company is selected to be on the bidders' list, your company name, your designated company representative's name and business contact information may be posted on public websites.
