- 5. Identify location of operating facility and any established local infrastructure.

Describe your experience operating under and familiarity with, the benefits provisions of the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Act, and your experience with any similar regimes in other parts of Canada or internationally. At the NRFP stage, if EMCP, EMCL, or HMDC choose in their sole discretion to proceed with an NRFP, proponents will be required to indicate how they comply with the above.
- 7. Please acknowledge that responsible management personnel have read, understand and will support requirements to comply with the following, where applicable:
