Scope of Work Overview:

The scope of work/supply includes, but is not limited to:

1. Provide equipment and service to collect downhole pressure and temperature data in oil and gas wells from the outside of different sizes of cemented casing strings and across multiple reservoirs.

Additionally, the selected supplier will be required to meet all technical and Safety, Security, Health, and Environmental (SSHE) specifications and safe work practices of EMCP, HMDC and their affiliates as appropriate.

Minimum Technical Requirements

The selected supplier will be required to provide downhole cemented gauges that:

- Can transmit and collect accurate pressure and temperature data at surface in a drilling and production platform environment.
- Can be fixed to the casing string and installed in a carrier that can protect the gauge while running in hole.
- Can be cemented in place.
- Can read reservoir pressure and temperature data across cement.
- Are cableless; cable(s) to surface on outside of casing not possible.
- Can provide data for a minimum of 10 years with downhole temperatures between 65 to 85 degrees Celsius.
- Can provide real-time daily data transmission to surface that is compatible with platform set-up and space limitations.
- Can operate in a variety of temperature ranges, up to 125 degrees Celsius.
- Are capable of meeting casing pressure test requirements.
- Are currently commercial (i.e., Equipment is not to be proposed that is in a testing or trial phase).
- Fit within the following well geometry:
 - o 432mm drilled hole size & made up to 340mm casing string;
 - o 311mm drilled hole size & made up to 244mm casing string; and
 - o 216mm drilled hole size & made up to 140mm casing or liner string.
- Multiple gauges must be able to be run in a single well, on the same casing string or on different casing strings.
